The 3rd Annual: 2018 Joseph Lodge #81 AF&AM Western Style Target Shoot

This is a regional match and fundraiser for Joseph Lodge #81 AF&AM Please attend, have fun, test your skills and support the activities of this local Fraternal Organization

When: Saturday, May 12, 2018 at 9:00 AM

Cost: \$30 per individual

Awards: Prizes will be a Heritage Single Action .22 pistol for the best Pistol Score and another Heritage Single Action .22 pistol for the best Rifle Score. All persons who purchase an entry, will be entered in a drawing for a Winchester 30-06 rifle with a Nikon scope. There will be about \$200 worth of other prizes and gift certificates. Firearm prizes will be available at Joseph Hardware after background checks which are the responsibility of the winner.

Location: The Eagle Cap Shooters Association range on Ant Flat Road. Ant Flat Road is reached by driving north about 7 miles, on State Highway 3 from Enterprise. Turn right (at the Eagle Cap Shooters sign) onto Ant Flat Road. The gate into the range facility is located on the left side of Ant Flat road, about one mile from Highway 3.

What will shooters need: There will be one set of stages to be shot with a single action, centerfire pistol. Bring at least 25 rounds of pistol ammunition. There will be one set of stages for center fire, lever action rifle. Bring at least 20 rounds of rifle ammunition. Targets will be steel and/or paper. Steel targets will have to be knocked down, so larger calibers have an advantage. Pistol distances will be 10-20 yards and rifle will be 100-200 yards. No optics allowed, open sights or “period correct, peep sights” only.

Will appropriate firearms be available to use: A single action pistol and a lever action rifle will be available for use. Be prepared to purchase the ammunition at the range.

Other considerations: Please bring eye and ear protection and appropriate clothing for spring weather. Bring whatever hydration or snacks you will need. Depending on the number of participants we expect to be finished by about noon.
