## **New Business**

### **Computerize IDPA Scoring**

Bob Jones and Ron Fox discussed the possibility of scoring IDPA matches with Amazon Fire HD 8 tablets. Scoring manually takes many hours of work after the matches and are subject to shooters questioning the results. An application for scoring IDPA matches in real time is available on HD 8 tablets. The shooter’s score is verified by the shooter at each stage. Results are summarized at the end of a match.

On a motion by Bill Oliver and seconded by Tyler Stucki the Board and membership authorized funds to purchase several Amazon Fire HD 8 tablets and software.

Approval was made by the Board to advertise an upcoming Appleseed event for the La Grande Rifle and Pistol club on the ECSA website.
