New Business

Educational and Safety Building Update

The Eagle Cap Shooters Educational Alliance (ECSEA) was donated \$42k from a trust fund to build a multipurpose educational and safety building at the range. The ECSEA will finance the building and arrange a lease to ECSA to use the building.

Steve Wolfe presented a proposal for a 20x40 foot educational and safety building. The current proposal calls for a 20x20 concrete slab. The other 20x20 foot area will remain gravel for now. The building will initially have a 20 foot wall on the north side of the building and a 40 foot wall on the west side of the building. The west and south walls will be open initially. The gravel area will be covered and will be used multi-purposes, such as, open air class room, picnic area, etc. In the NW corner of the building will be 16x20 foot enclosed and lockable storage area with 14 foot wide roll up door on the east side of the storage area. There will also be a lockable man door to the storage area. See attached notes.

Members are encouraged to donate dollars to ECSEA for support this project. ECSEA is a 501 (c) 3 organization. Donations are tax deductible.

Unintended Discharges
