Doug Wickre reported that the Friends of NRA grant meeting he attended in Redmond split the grants with 70% of the monies going to youth organizations, such as, FFA, 4H, ROTC, etc. Only 30% of the monies went to organizations such as ECSA. Unfortunately, the \$8000 ECSA requested was not granted for 2018. Doug noted that no grants were approved for range development with most of it going to youth group scholarships.
