Questions were raised including: Do we need the ECSEA? Can the ECSA be the 501(c)3 if the Alliance were eliminated? Bob said if the ECSEA were to be dissolved, all monies collected by the Alliance would have to go to another 501(c)3, which the ECSA is not. Bob will need to discuss further with Doug and the attorney.
