Indemnification. THE UNDERSIGNED, _____, a MEMBER of the Eagle Cap Shooters hereby agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Eagle Cap Shooters, an Oregon non-profit corporation, and their respective instructors, contractors, officers, members, employees, volunteers, and agents (Collectively referred to as "ECS"), from any and all fault, liabilities, expenses, claims, demands or lawsuits arising out of, related to or connected with my presence at and/or participation in any course of instruction, any shooting competitions, the discharge of firearms, any and all of my acts and/or omissions, and any and all acts and/or omissions of a third party arising out of, related to or connected with ECS's range, buildings, and premises (hereinafter "ECS's Shooting Range") and my presence on or use of ECS's Shooting Range, including any latent defects in the buildings or premises.

Waiver of Claims. I voluntarily waive for myself and for my executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, any and all rights and claims against ECS for damages, losses, demands, and any other actions or claims and/or any and all injuries, damages, and illnesses suffered by me or my property (including, but not limited to, my death), which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with my presence at and/or participation in any course of instruction, any shooting competitions, the discharge of firearms, any and all of my acts and/or omissions, and any and all acts and/or omissions of a third party arising out of, related to or connected with ECS's Shooting Range and my presence on or use of ECS's Shooting Range, including any latent defects in the buildings or premises.

Release of Claims. I agree that ECS shall not be liable for any and all such claims and liabilities described above, and I, on behalf of myself and on behalf of my executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, hereby expressly release ECS from any and all such claims and liabilities described above.
